 - **45** individuals trained

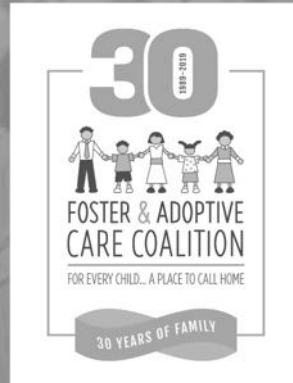
Caregiver Responses

Partner Responses
